The Indigenous Math and Science Institute (IMSI) seeks designs for two logos, one for IMSI and one for its affiliate program, the All Nations Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (ANLSAMP). Both competitions are open to all students attending ANSLAMP partner institutions.

1. The goal of IMSI is to provide an all-inclusive effort to promote Native American achievement at all levels of science, technology, engineering and mathematics education (STEM). IMSI works K-12, undergraduate and graduate STEM programs across the nation.
2. ANLSAMP's mission is to dramatically increase the number of American Indians receiving Bachelor's degrees in STEM. ANLSAMP works with 52 institutions including 32 tribal colleges across the United States.

Each program seeks its own distinct logo which will be used in the programs national public relations campaign. Students are encouraged to submit a logo for each competition. Each program's logo will be judged separately.

Parameters for the designs are:

- The over all logo must include the program name.
- The emphasis for ANLSAMP is on "All Nations."
- Logos should work in both black and white and color.
- Logos need to be submitted in color and black and white.
- Must be submitted as 3 1/2 x 5 inch graphic.
