Scholarships will be awarded to students who:

- Meet the eligibility requirements
- Are selected based on the application review
- Provide all the requested information
- Comply with the mentorship requirement

Eligibility

You are eligible to apply if you are a student who is:

- A U.S. Citizen
- Enrolled full-time in an engineering, science, or technology field
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Attending an ANLSAMP Tribal College

Application Requirements

To apply the applicant must provide:

- Completed and signed application form
- Official transcripts from college attending
- Proof of full-time enrollment at college attending
- Two letters of recommendation from staff or faculty at the college you are attending
- Letter of acceptance from the college you are attending stating your declared major
- 500 word essay

Applications will be reviewed by a committee on the basis of eligibility and completeness.

Awards will be made in two disbursements.
